

BED BUG TREATMENT

BEFORE WE TREAT:

- Except for furniture, clear everything off the floor, even in the closets.
- Vacuum the floor, the baseboards and any area where your animals sit or sleep, including the couch, chairs, counters or windowsills. After a thorough vacuuming, remove the bag, seal it in a plastic bag, and put it in the outside trash.
- Wash the floors. If your carpets need cleaning, do it before the treatment, or 3 months after the treatment. We recommend **Carpet Solutions** 1-800-287-0002 or **www.thecarpetsolution.com**
- Wash and dry all bedding and clothing on high heat – including pet beds, but don't remake the beds until after the treatment.
- Remove pets for the day. If you have a fish tank, cover it and unplug the filter until you are back in the house.
- Remove all cloths and objects from dressers and night stands in bedrooms

AFTER WE TREAT:

- Surfaces must be completely dry before you walk on them or allow children to play on them.
- Estimate being out of your house for 6 to 8 hours after treatment.
- Ventilate the house when you return.
- Don't vacuum for at least 10 – 14 days after treatment, and don't wash the floors for three days after the treatment.
- Bag the box spring and mattress

WHAT TO EXPECT:

- The insecticide will last for up to 7 months if it is not removed.
- You may still see some bed bug activity for several days after treatment.
 - Newly hatched bedbugs have not come in contact with pesticide yet.

For our treatment to be successful, you need to do the preparation and follow-up!
